**Summary of the implementation of scientific research results  
«Economic and Environmental Priorities of the Green Economy in the Context of  
Ukraine's Sustainable Development»**

*(Registration No.0118U006524, performance period: 01.09.2018 - 31.12.2019)*

**Based on the results of applied developments, positive feedback and implementation information were received, in particular:**

**1. The Department of Ecology and Natural Resources of the Odesa Regional State Administration** (outgoing letter No. 8074/06-21/5503 dated 17.12.2018) positively assessed the analytical note «*Institutional Support for Activating the Process of Greening the Ukrainian National Model of a 'Green Economy'.*» It was noted that the provisions of the note will be used when preparing management decisions to improve the development of the «green economy» as a tool of environmental and agricultural policy and when forming environmental and agricultural programs.

**2. The Department of Ecology and Natural Resources of the Odesa Regional State Administration** (outgoing letter No. 8303/06-21/5639 dated 22.12.2018) positively assessed the analytical report «*Methodological Support for Determining Economic and Environmental Priorities of the 'Green Economy' in the Context of Sustainable Development in Ukraine.*» It was noted that the substantiated methodological support proposed in the report, particularly for determining economic and environmental priorities and monitoring «green indicators» based on sustainable development principles, will be considered in the Department's work.

**3. The Department of Agrarian Policy of the Odesa Regional State Administration** (outgoing letter No. 2025/03-4//03/1190 dated 13.12.2018) positively assessed the analytical note «*Institutional Support for Activating the Process of Greening the Ukrainian National Model of a 'Green Economy'.*» It was noted that the provisions of the note will be used in preparing management decisions to improve the development of the «green economy» as a tool of environmental and agricultural policy and in forming ecological and agricultural programs.

**4. Columbus International LLC** (outgoing letter No. 54 dated 12.12.2018) positively assessed the analytical note «*Methodological Provisions for Monitoring Economic and Environmental Indicators for Achieving Sustainable Development Goals 2 ('Zero Hunger, Agricultural Development') and 12 ('Responsible Consumption and Production') in the Context of 'Green Growth' in Ukraine.*» The monitoring results for achieving SDG 12, using an extended system of economic and environmental indicators based on sustainable development, including waste management indicators proposed by the authors, will be used by Columbus International LLC to justify a waste management mechanism, minimize environmental impact, and develop a strategy for introducing innovative clean technologies for «green modernization» of production, considering global and national market trends.

**5. The Department of Agrarian Policy of the Odesa Regional State Administration** (outgoing letter No. 2048/03-4//03/1214 dated 22.12.2018) positively

assessed the analytical note «*Methodological Provisions for Monitoring Economic and Environmental Indicators for Achieving Sustainable Development Goals 2 and 12 in the Context of 'Green Growth' in Ukraine.*» It was noted that the monitoring results will be used to assess the development trends of organic production in the region, determine strategic goals for «green growth» in the agricultural sector, and develop strategic agricultural and food market programs based on sustainable development principles.

**6. The Department of Agrarian Policy of the Odesa Regional State Administration** (outgoing letter No. 2049/03-4//03/1213 dated 22.12.2018) positively assessed the analytical report «*Methodological Support for Determining Economic and Environmental Priorities of the 'Green Economy' in the Context of Sustainable Development in Ukraine.*» The scientific and applied provisions of the report will be used to justify regional development directions, create effective mechanisms for implementing environmentally friendly production in agriculture, and determine its investment and innovation priorities for the «green modernization» of the region's economy.

**7. The Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources of Ukraine** (outgoing letter No. 5/3-10/283-19 dated 08.01.2019) positively assessed the analytical report «*Methodological Support for Determining Economic and Environmental Priorities of the 'Green Economy' in the Context of Sustainable Development in Ukraine.*» The developments regarding the impact of key economic indicators on environmental indicators during monitoring of SDG achievement in Ukraine will be used by the Ministry in its work.

**8. The Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources of Ukraine** (outgoing letter No. 5/3-10/284-19 dated 08.01.2019) positively assessed the memorandum «*Trends in the Development of Innovative Foundations for Ecosystem Services in Ukraine and the EU as a Component of the 'Green Economy'.*» It was noted that the provisions of the memorandum will be used in the implementation of the Habitats Directive «*Conservation of Natural Habitats and of Wild Fauna and Flora*» (92/43/EEC, 1992).

**9. The Department of Transport, Communication, and Traffic Management** (outgoing letter No. 0141/116 dated 17.01.2019) positively assessed the analytical note «*Methodological Provisions for Monitoring Economic and Environmental Indicators for Achieving Sustainable Development Goal 9 ('Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure').*» It was noted that the proposed indicators are timely, scientifically substantiated, and useful for developing urban transport and infrastructure plans in Odesa.

**10. The Department of Transport, Communication, and Traffic Management** (outgoing letter No. 0141/117 dated 17.01.2019) positively assessed the memorandum «*Methodological Provisions for Monitoring Economic and Environmental Indicators for Achieving Sustainable Development Goal 11 ('Sustainable Cities and Communities').*» It was noted that the materials will be used to develop urban transport and infrastructure plans in Odesa.

**11. The Odesa Regional Council** (outgoing letter No. 147/01/03-38/135 dated 23.01.2019) positively assessed the memorandum «*Trends in the Development of Innovative Foundations for Ecosystem Services in Ukraine and the EU as a Component of the 'Green Economy'.*» The authors' suggestion regarding the allocation of funds to local budgets for ecosystem conservation was recognized as appropriate for forming regional policies on natural resource restoration.

12. **The Public Council under the State Agency for Water Resources of Ukraine** (outgoing letter No. 15 dated 08.02.2019) positively assessed the analytical note «*Methodological Provisions for Monitoring Economic and Environmental Indicators for Achieving Sustainable Development Goal 15 ('Life on Land')*.» The proposals will be used in the Council's work to evaluate environmental conditions in Ukraine.

13. **The State Agency for Water Resources of Ukraine** (outgoing letter No. 7980/3/4/11-18 dated 21.12.2018) positively assessed the analytical note «*Institutional Support for Activating the Process of Greening the Ukrainian National Model of a 'Green Economy'*.» The proposals developed in the note will be used in preparing decisions in the field of water management and land reclamation.

14. **The Department of Ecology and Natural Resources of the Odesa Regional State Administration** (outgoing letter No. 3832/06-20/3709 dated 22.07.2019) positively assessed the memorandum «*Theoretical and Methodological Approaches to Achieving 'Green Growth' and Sustainable Development Goals through Responsible Waste Management*.» The proposals developed in the memorandum will be considered when forming a regional waste management program.

15. **The Department of Agrarian Policy of the Odesa Regional State Administration** (outgoing letter No. 1084/01/863 dated 11.10.2019) positively assessed the scientific report «*Mechanisms for Ensuring the Greening of Land Use Based on the Priorities of 'Green Growth' in Ukrainian Regions under Decentralization*.» The proposals were used by the Department in developing regional programs for agricultural production, innovation, and investment forecasts.

16. **The Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources of Ukraine** (outgoing letter No. 3-14/4944-19 dated 11.05.2019) positively assessed the analytical note «*Methodological Recommendations for Assessing the Impact of Economic Indicators on the Main Indicators of 'Green Growth'*.» The recommendations were reviewed and implemented by the Working Group on Water Quality and Resource Management.
