Summary of the implementation of scientific research results «Imperatives of Socially Responsible Business Based on Economy Ecologization»

(Registration No.0122U000748, performance period: 04.01.2022 - 31.12.2022)

Based on the results of applied developments, positive feedback and implementation information were received, in particular:

1. The Department of Agrarian Policy, Food, and Land Relations of the Odesa Regional State Administration (outgoing letter No. 154/APK dated 23.11.2022) positively assessed the analytical report *«Methodological Recommendations for Comprehensive Assessment of Socially Responsible Production and Consumption in the Context of Post-War Economic Recovery in Ukraine.»* It was noted that the materials can be used to monitor the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the agri-food sector, justify priority areas for developing socially responsible production and consumption in the agricultural sector, and develop programs for strategic agricultural and food market development in the region based on sustainable development principles.

2. The Department of Economic Policy and Strategic Planning of the Odesa Regional State Administration (outgoing letter No. 365/02/01.1-06/2-22/10218 dated 28.11.2022) positively assessed the analytical report *«Imperatives and Institutional Support for Socially Responsible Business on the Basis of Greening the Economy.»* It emphasized the value of the proposed approaches for adapting the national concept of socially responsible business to best global practices and European requirements, particularly in German-speaking countries, and determining the imperatives and institutional foundations for achieving business efficiency through greening. The applied provisions were used by the Department when planning and substantiating strategic directions for developing socially responsible business in the Odesa region during the post-war period.

3. The Department of Ecology and Natural Resources of the Odesa Regional State Administration (outgoing letter No. 2797/06/06-17/2-22/4383 dated 26.11.2022) positively assessed the memorandum *«Imperatives of Ecological Development of Socially Responsible Business in the Context of a Circular Economy Model.»* It was noted that the proposed conditions for implementing ecologically oriented socially responsible business within a mixed circular economy model have practical significance for strategic planning in the Odesa region. The scientific and methodological results will be used by the Department in implementing state policies on environmental protection and the rational use of natural resources.

4. The Department of Social and Family Policy of the Odesa Regional State Administration (outgoing letter No. 307/01-40/2-23/118 dated 10.01.2023) positively assessed the memorandum *«Imperatives of Ecological Development of Socially Responsible Business in the Context of a Circular Economy Model.»* It highlighted the practical importance of modern imperatives for developing socially responsible business through greening during the post-war period. The analytical and methodological results will be partially used by the Department to substantiate and shape modern approaches to

projects for socially responsible business in regional socio-economic development programs.

5. **The Odesa Regional Humanitarian Center for Extracurricular Education and Upbringing, under the Department of Education and Science of the Odesa Regional State Administration** (outgoing letter No. 06-04/03 dated 04.01.2023), positively assessed the analytical report «*Imperatives and Institutional Support for Socially Responsible Business on the Basis of Greening the Economy.*» It emphasized the comprehensive analysis of imperatives, institutional foundations, and best European practices for establishing socially responsible business globally (using German-speaking EU countries, including Germany, as an example). The report's main scientific provisions will be implemented in the Center's practical activities.

6. **Columbus International LLC** (outgoing letter No. 115 dated 21.11.2021) positively assessed the analytical report «*Methodological Recommendations for Comprehensive Assessment of Socially Responsible Production and Consumption in the Context of Post-War Economic Recovery in Ukraine.*» It was noted that the methodological recommendations can be used for assessing the status and dynamics of socially responsible production and consumption, identifying additional opportunities to improve environmental performance, ensuring professional training of employees on environmental protection, health, and safety issues, and substantiating the strategic directions of enterprise development based on sustainability and the circular economy.
