**Summary of the implementation of scientific research results
“Selective regulation of the development of commodity markets”**

(Registration No. 0122U000825, performance period: 01.01.2022–30.06.2024)

Based on the results of applied developments, positive feedback and implementation information were received, in particular:

1. Department of Agrarian Policy, Food, and Land Relations of the Odesa Regional State Administration (letter No. 26/153 dated 13.07.2022) positively assessed the scientific report *"Theoretical Basis of Selective Regulation of Commodity Market Development Considering Foreign Experience under Economic Recovery Conditions."* It was noted that the materials were used in the preparation of strategic documents for the post-war economic recovery of the region and ensuring its food security, as well as in the development of programs for the growth of strategic agricultural and food markets in the region.

2. Department of Agrarian Policy, Food, and Land Relations of the Odesa Regional State Administration (letter No. 26/315 dated 21.11.2022, incoming No. 155/APC dated 23.11.2022) positively assessed the memo *"Enhancing the Development of the Dairy Market in the System of Vertically Related Dairy Markets."* It was noted that the materials were used in the preparation of strategic documents on food security in the region during the wartime and post-war periods.

3. The Antimonopoly Committee of Ukraine (letter No. 126-29.3/01-1492e dated 23.08.2022) positively assessed the memo *"Proposals for the Implementation of State Regulation of Retail Trade Networks' Relations with Suppliers under the Conditions of Economic Recovery after the War."* It was noted that the memo's materials would be used in the development of regulatory documents aimed at improving legislation on economic competition protection.

4. Odesa Regional Branch of the All-Ukrainian Public Organization "Union of Experts of Ukraine" (letter No. 29-1 dated 29.07.2022) positively assessed the scientific report *"Theoretical Basis of Selective Regulation of Commodity Market Development Considering Foreign Experience under Economic Recovery Conditions."* It was noted that the report's materials were used for consulting commodity market entities on financial and economic activities under conditions of instability.

5. Odesa Regional Branch of the All-Ukrainian Public Organization "Union of Experts of Ukraine" (letter No. 24/2 dated 24.11.2021) positively assessed the memo *"Enhancing the Development of the Dairy Market in the System of Vertically Related Dairy Markets."* It was noted that the memo's materials were

used during consulting activities to determine strategic directions for the development of business entities under wartime and post-war conditions, as well as in the scientific and methodological work of the organization, related to creating new and improving existing methodologies.

6. **LLC "Istyna"** (letter No. 1/29 dated 29.07.2022) positively assessed the scientific report *"Theoretical Basis of Selective Regulation of Commodity Market Development Considering Foreign Experience under Economic Recovery Conditions."* It was noted that the developed methodological and applied principles were used for consulting activities on substantiating promising types of activities for agri-food market entities.

7. **LLC "Columbus International"** (letter No. 112 dated 19.09.2022) positively assessed the scientific report *"Theoretical Basis of Selective Regulation of Commodity Market Development Considering Foreign Experience under Economic Recovery Conditions."* It was noted that the applied results of the report were used in substantiating the marketing strategy for entering external markets, as well as in developing adaptive mechanisms for selective regulation of commodity-financial flows in regional markets under instability conditions.

9. **LLC "Columbus International"** (letter No. 116 dated 19.09.2022) positively assessed the memo *"Enhancing the Development of the Dairy Market in the System of Vertically Related Dairy Markets."* It was noted that the applied provisions of the memo were used in substantiating the enterprise's prospective development directions, aligning its internal capabilities with external environmental conditions, and developing a set of selective measures to ensure the realization of the enterprise's resource potential under instability conditions.

10. **Association of Ukrainian Cities (Odessa Branch)** (letter No. 53 dated 08.11.2022) positively assessed the scientific report *"Selective Approach to the Regulation of Local Essential Goods Markets under Post-War Conditions."* It was noted that the report's materials would be used in the development of economic development strategies under post-war recovery conditions.

11. **State Regulatory Service of Ukraine** (letter No. 4452/20-23 dated 09.11.2023) positively assessed the scientific report *"Improving State Regulation of Commodity Markets Based on the Selective Approach: Global Experience and Its Implementation in Ukraine."* It was noted that the report's materials would be used in the development of regulatory acts aimed at improving regulatory policy in the field of economic activity.

Period." It was noted that the memo's materials were used in the preparation of programmatic and strategic documents regarding the regulation of dairy market development at the regional and local levels, as well as the justification of mechanisms for implementing state agrarian policy under instability conditions.

13. Department of Agrarian Policy, Food, and Land Relations of the Odesa Regional State Administration (letter No. 140/APC dated 27.09.2023) positively assessed the scientific report *"Methodological Approach and Recommendations for Comprehensive Assessment of the Functioning and Regulation of Commodity Market Development Based on Resilience Principles Under Instability Conditions."* It was noted that the materials were used in the preparation of programmatic and strategic documents regarding the regulation of agri-food market development, as well as in the justification of methodological support for assessing the stability of their functioning under instability conditions.

14. Department of Agrarian Policy, Food, and Land Relations of the Odesa Regional State Administration (letter No. 161/APC dated 24.10.2023) positively assessed the analytical memo *"Institutional and Economic Mechanisms for Selective Regulation of the Poultry Meat and Egg Market in the Context of Food Security."* It was noted that the memo's materials were used in the preparation of strategic documents to ensure regional food security during the wartime and post-war periods, as well as in the development of programs for the growth of strategic agricultural and food markets in the region.

15. Department of Agrarian Policy, Food, and Land Relations of the Odesa Regional State Administration (letter No. 187/APC dated 30.11.2023) positively assessed the analytical report *"Institutional Support for the Stability of the Compound Feed Market During the Wartime and Post-War Periods."* It was noted that the materials were used to justify mechanisms for regulating compound feed markets and to develop strategies for the sustainable development of agri-food markets.

16. Department of Agrarian Policy, Food, and Land Relations of the Odesa Regional State Administration (letter No. 211/APC dated 29.12.2023) positively assessed the analytical memo *"Institutional Mechanisms for Selective Regulation of Ukraine's Vegetable Market During the Wartime and Post-War Periods."* It was noted that the materials were used in the preparation of programmatic and strategic documents regarding the regulation of vegetable market development at the regional and local levels, as well as in the justification of mechanisms for implementing state agrarian policy under instability conditions.

19. **Odesa Regional Branch of the All-Ukrainian Public Organization "Union of Experts of Ukraine"** (letter No. 22 dated 26.09.2023) positively assessed the scientific report *"Methodological Approach and Recommendations for Comprehensive Assessment of the Functioning and Regulation of Commodity Market Development Based on Resilience Principles Under Instability Conditions."* It was noted that the materials were used to develop new methodologies for analyzing commodity markets under instability conditions.

20. **Odesa Regional Branch of the All-Ukrainian Public Organization "Union of Experts of Ukraine"** (letter No. 23 dated 06.10.2023) positively assessed the scientific report *"Improving State Regulation of Commodity Markets Based on the Selective Approach: Global Experience and Its Implementation in Ukraine."* It was noted that the report's applied provisions were used by the Union of Experts of Ukraine during consulting activities with business entities engaged in international activities and exploring foreign commodity markets under instability conditions.

22. **Odesa Regional Branch of the All-Ukrainian Public Organization "Union of Experts of Ukraine"** (letter No. 32 dated 30.11.2023) positively assessed the analytical report *"Institutional Support for the Stability of the Compound Feed Market During the Wartime and Post-War Periods."* It was noted that the applied provisions of the report were used by the Union of Experts of Ukraine during consulting activities with business entities regarding institutional support for their stability during the wartime period, as well as in the scientific and methodological work of the organization aimed at improving existing methodologies for analyzing commodity markets under instability conditions.

23. **LLC "Columbus International"** (letter No. 39 dated 10.07.2023) positively assessed the analytical memo *"Institutional Support for the Stability of Local Dairy and Dairy Product Markets During the Wartime and Post-War Period."* It was noted that the memo's materials were used to justify an adaptive development strategy for the enterprise during the wartime period, expand commodity supply channels, and form extended distribution chains in the domestic market.

26. **LLC "Istyna"** (letter No. 1/24 dated 24.10.2023) positively assessed the memo *"Proposals for Improving the Regulatory and Legal Framework of the Domestic Dairy Market During the Wartime and Post-War Periods."* It was noted that the memo's materials were used to analyze the activities of dairy market business entities and plan priority areas for their development as socially responsible production.

27. **LLC "Istyna"** (letter No. 1/27 dated 27.12.2023) positively assessed the analytical memo *"Institutional Mechanisms for Selective Regulation of the Vegetable Market During the Wartime and Post-War Periods."* It was noted that the memo's materials were used by LLC "Istyna" in analyzing the activities of vegetable market business entities, as well as in consulting market participants on regulatory and legal issues under wartime conditions.
