**Summary of the implementation of scientific research results of  
research on the topic 3.1.8.82/B "INSTITUTIONAL MODERNIZATION OF  
THE ENTREPRENEURIAL SECTOR IN THE CONDITIONS OF LOCAL  
SELF-GOVERNANCE REFORM"**

**(№0122U002365, performance period: I 01.2022 - 12.2022)**

A draft program for the development of small (micro) entrepreneurship in territorial communities has been developed, the implementation tools of which are characterized by a focus on solving specific problems at the community level. The socio-economic consequences consist in increasing the number of entrepreneurs, the created added value and income of community budgets (in particular, in the Vyzyr community of the Odessa region, the application of program measures for the development of entrepreneurship contributed to the placement of more than 20 relocated entrepreneurs, with more than 150 additional jobs, which brings up to 2 million UAH of additional budget revenues to the local budget).

A draft passport of resource provision and capacity of the territorial community (settlement, settlement council, small town) and its constituent entities regarding local provision of entrepreneurship development has been developed.

A system of proposals for regulatory acts aimed at simplifying the conditions for doing business, attracting investments, creating new jobs and promoting effective relocation, adaptation of enterprises and the restoration of their business activity in the context of countering military aggression has been formed, recommendations for achieving the goals of the State Development Strategy for 2021-2027, which generally contribute to the implementation of the programs of the Recovery Plan of Ukraine.
